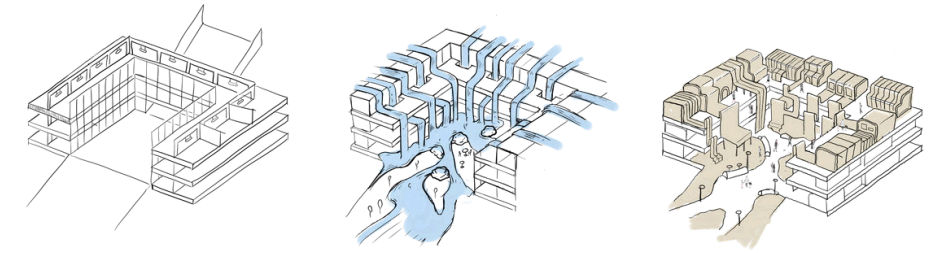

The Village Yuseong is a redevelopment of the historic Yuseong Hotel, a landmark with over 100 years of heritage. The project involves reconstructing the hotel while integrating a cultural complex on the lower floors, blending history, modern hospitality, and commercial vibrancy. For this project, with my team, we were responsible for the design of the lower-level façade, plaza, and F&B commercial spaces, focusing on creating a dynamic and engaging environment for both visitors and the local community.



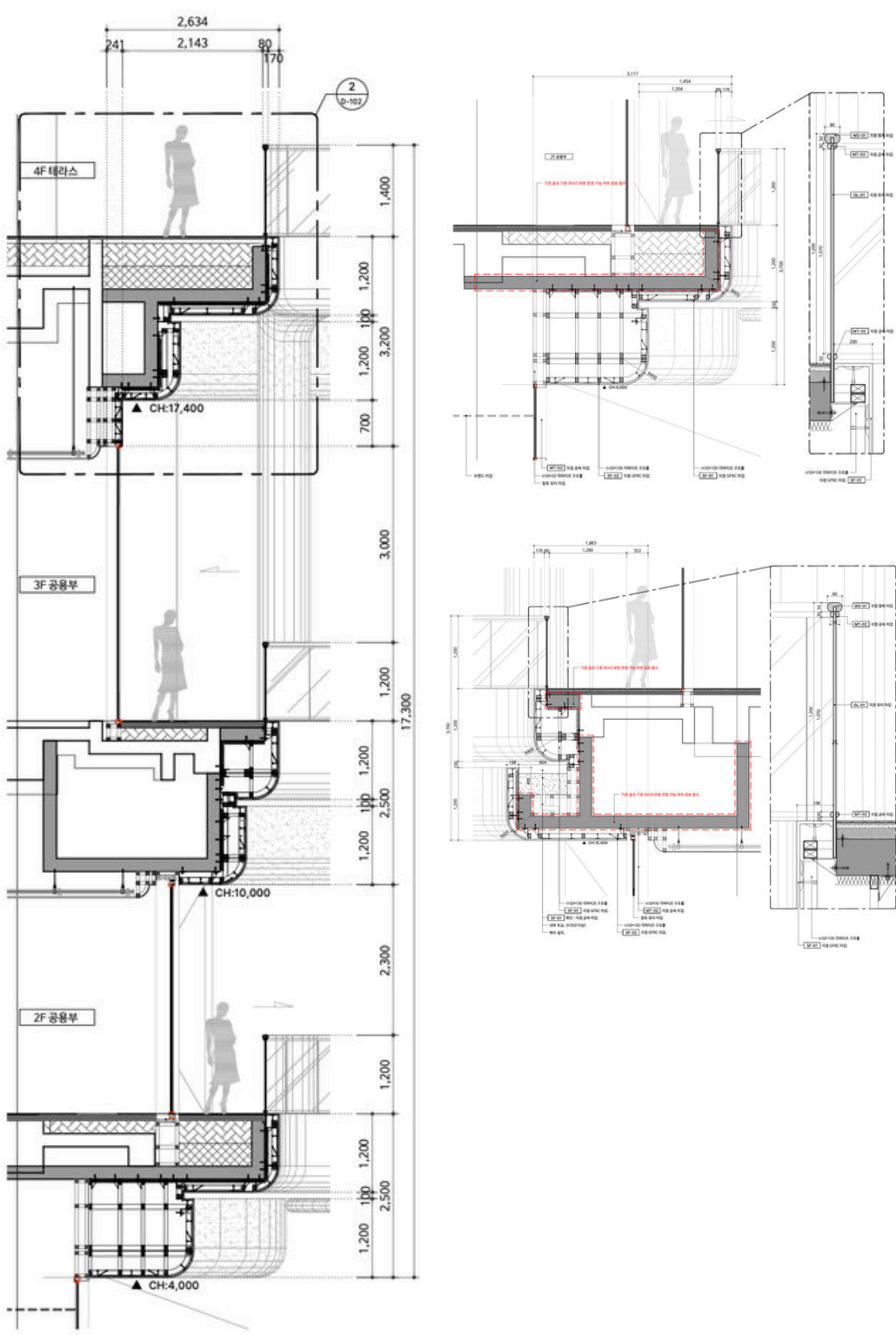
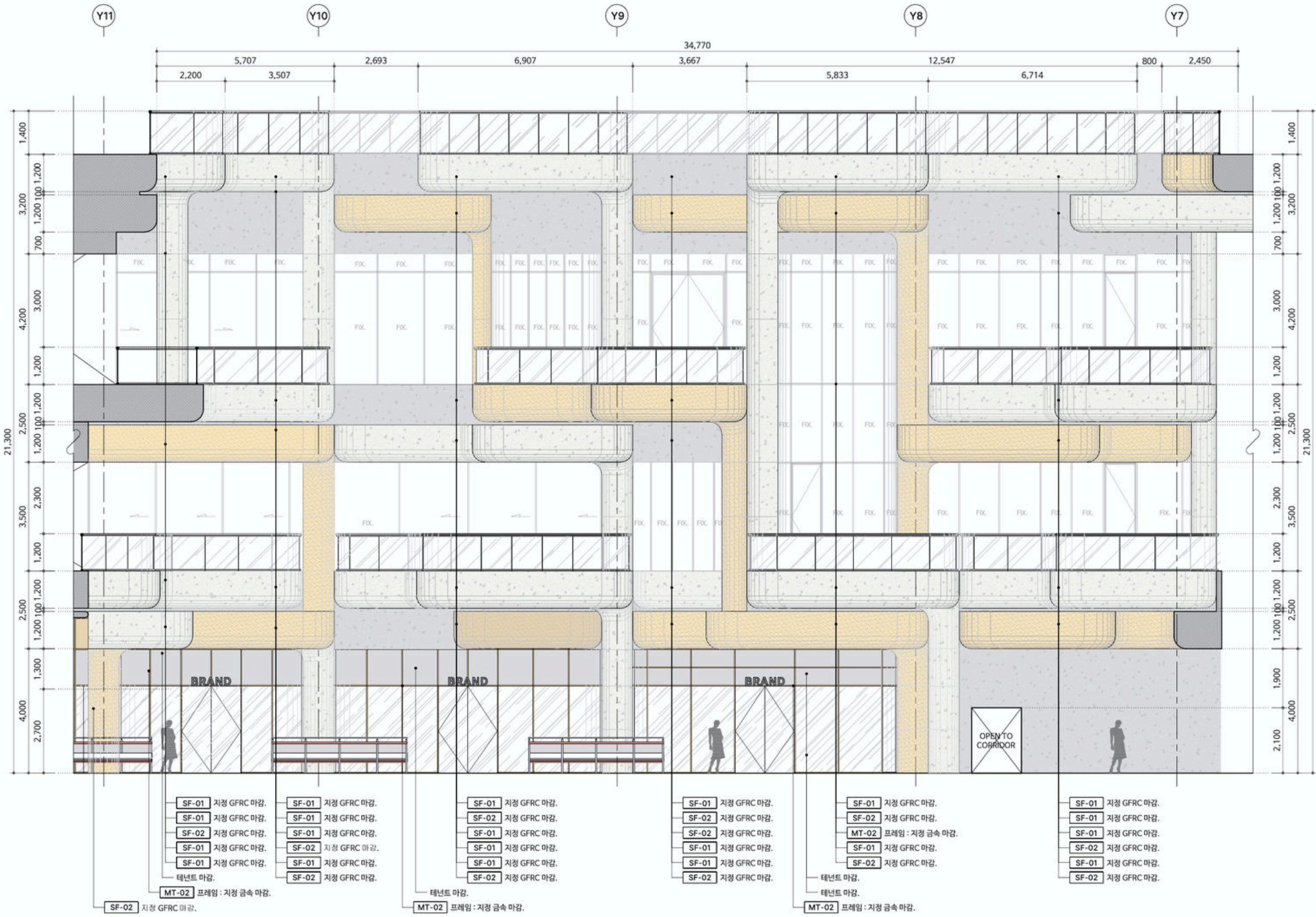
A Flowing Community Experience

The main experience is centered around the public terrace facing the plaza and the library terrace. Key views show the rounded-edge design language, soft tenant boundaries, and the connection to the library. The overall atmosphere is private, bright, and comfortable, with natural light coming into the space. Brick cross-stacking can be used to integrate signage, while pipe lighting adds a subtle design detail.



Facade Elevation / Detail

The facade is composed of sculptural GFRC panels inspired by the flow of water. The continuous organic form creates layered terraces and a garden-like courtyard, strengthening the connection between architecture, landscape, and the identity of Yuseong.

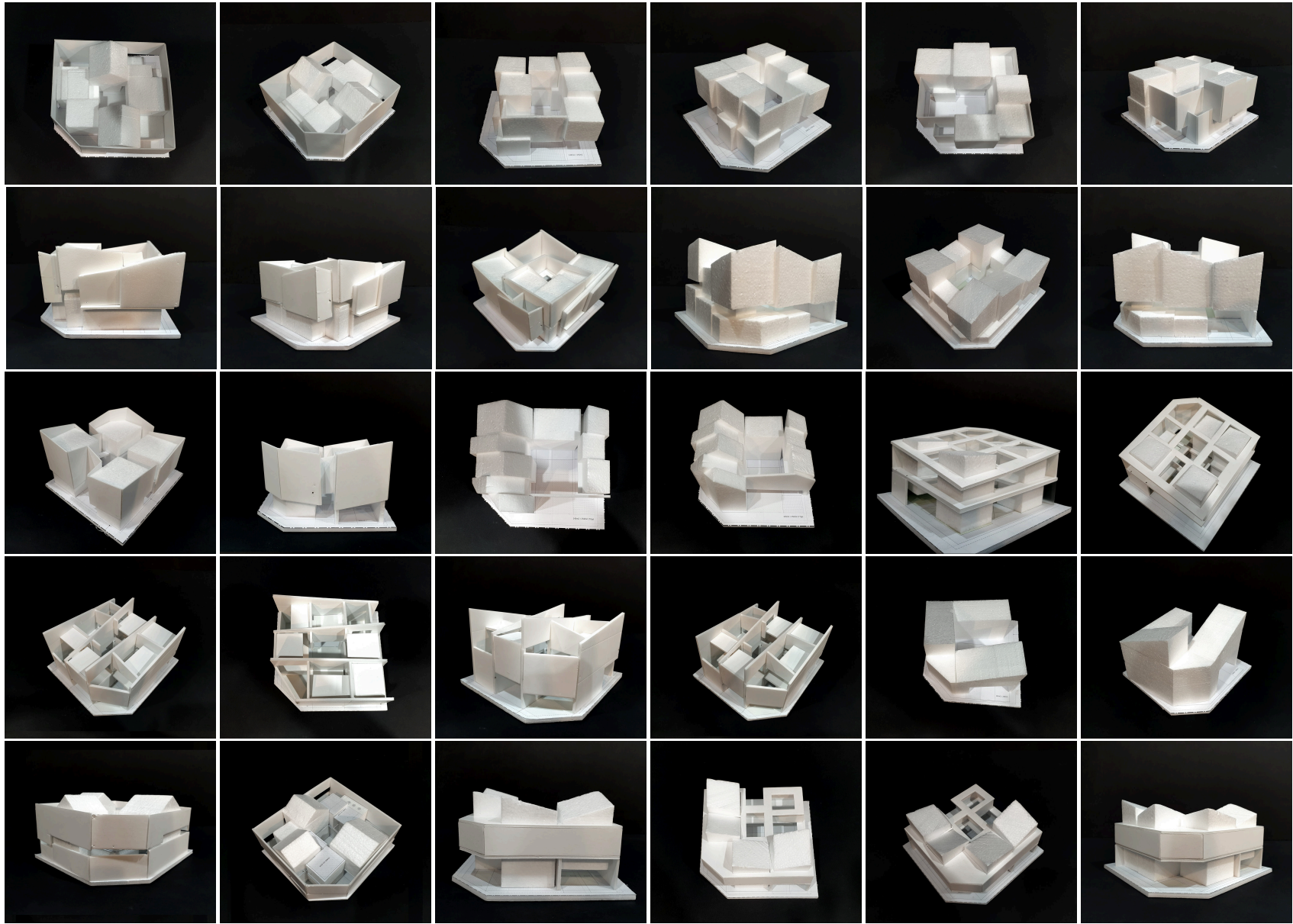

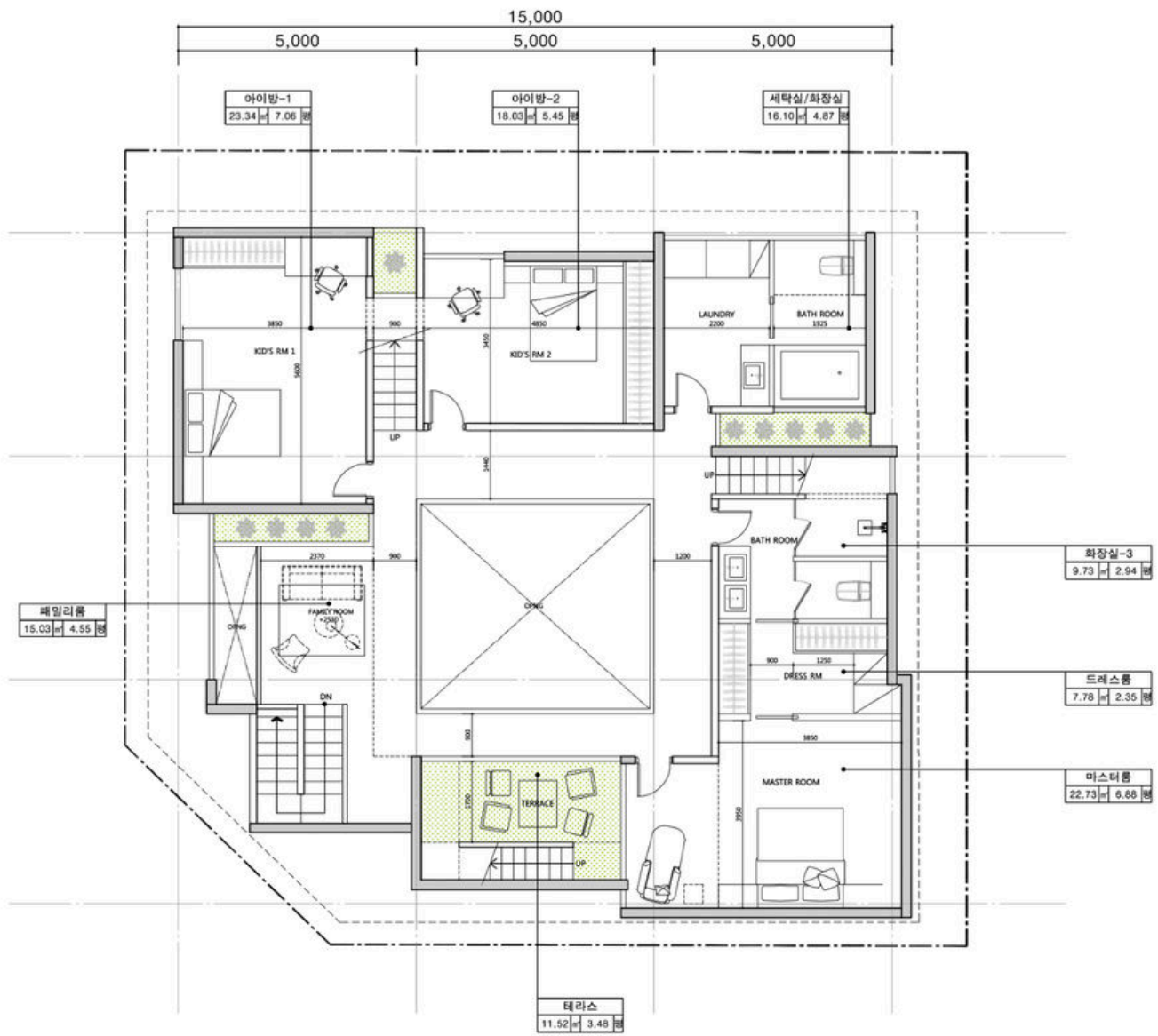
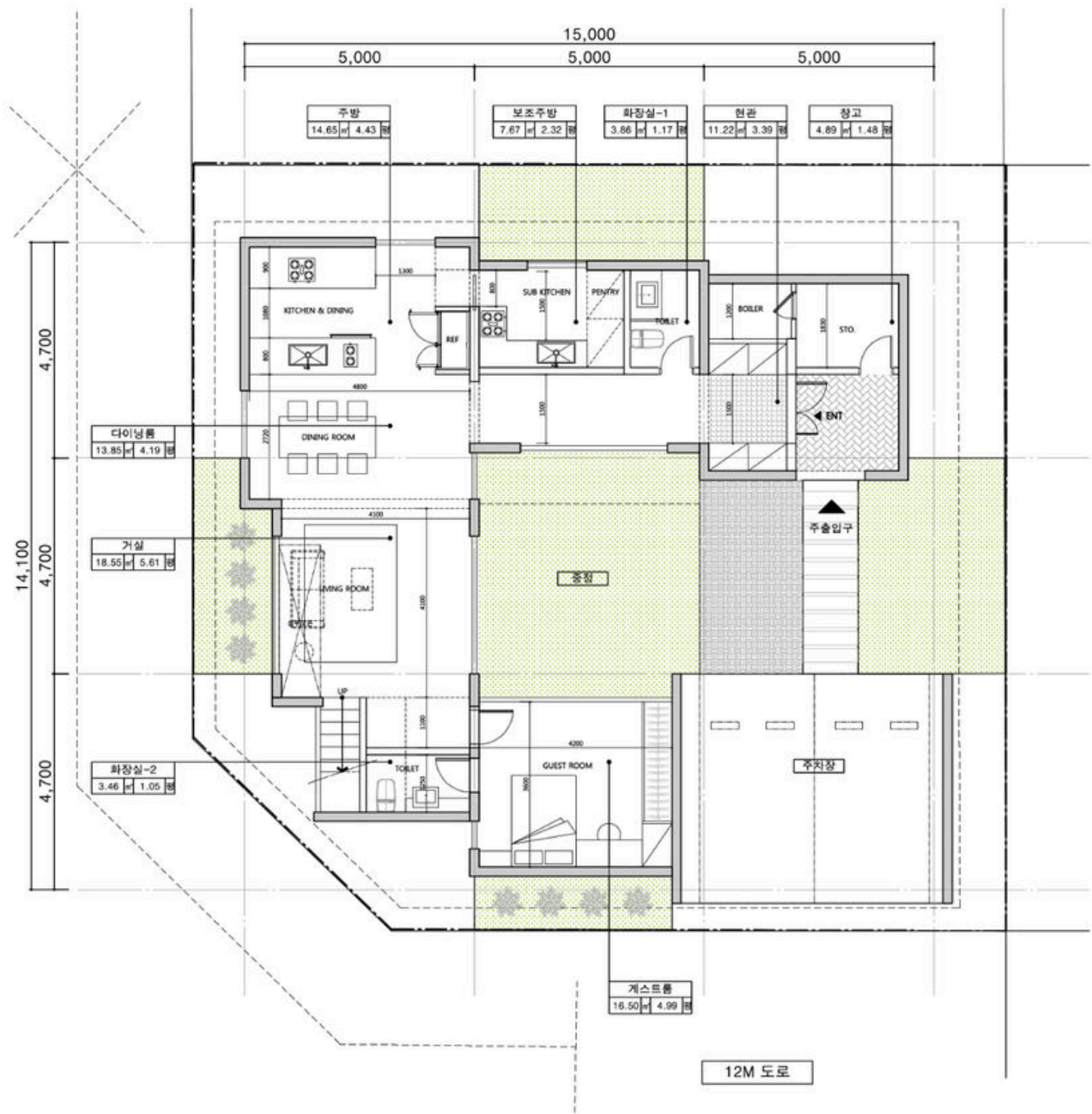


Mass studies

Client wanted a solid exterior for privacy. I studied different massing options to bring natural light inside while keeping the exterior closed. I also created a central courtyard to bring nature into the interior. The divided massing adds variety to the indoor spaces and creates a loft for children to play, as well as a rooftop space connected to nature.

Spatial Strategy_Floorplan concept

The site is divided into a 3x3 grid, with each cube containing different programs. A central courtyard and scattered pocket gardens connect the outdoor spaces, creating a residence filled with nature. The 3x3 Cube House is organized around a circulation path that flows around the central courtyard.

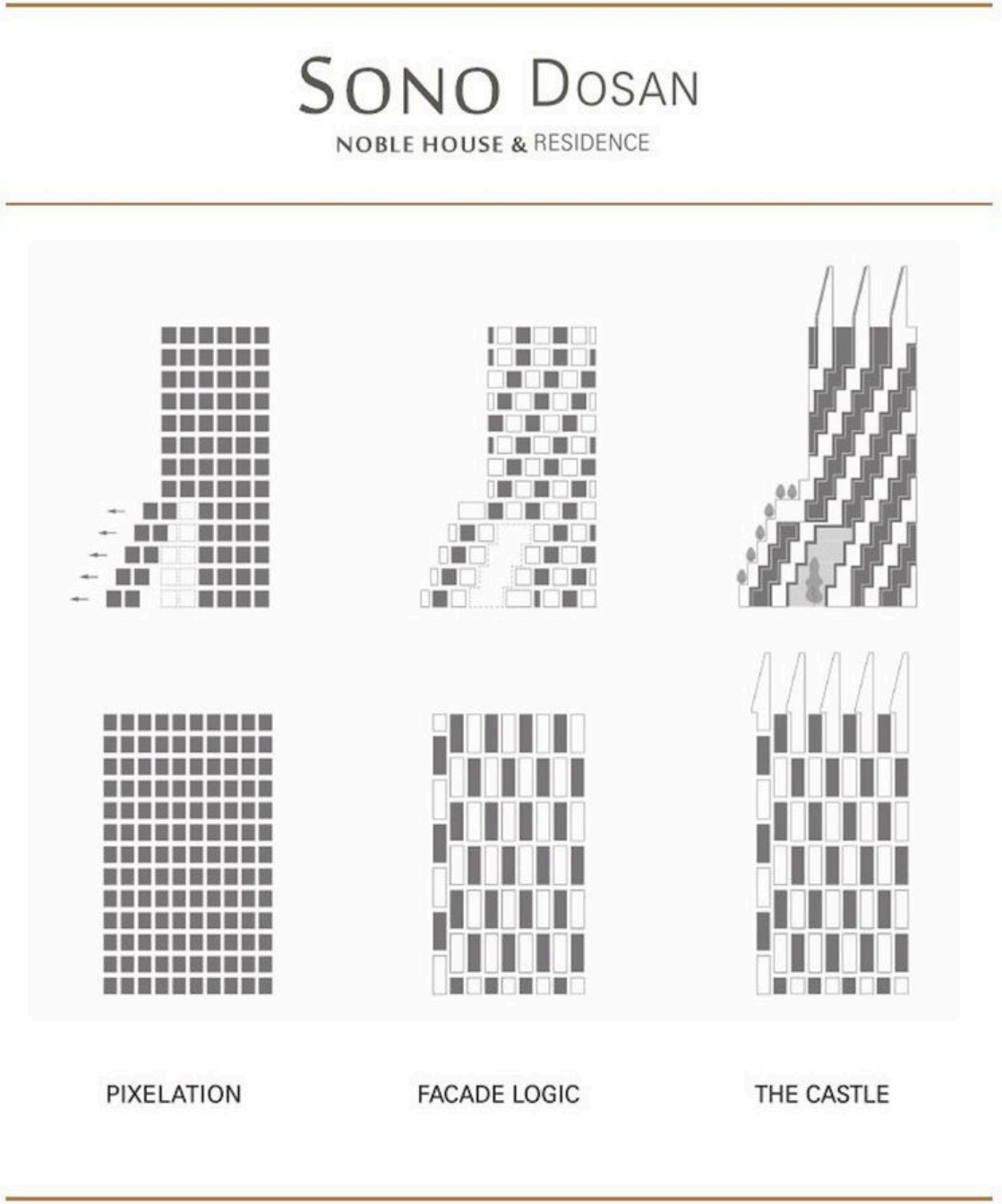
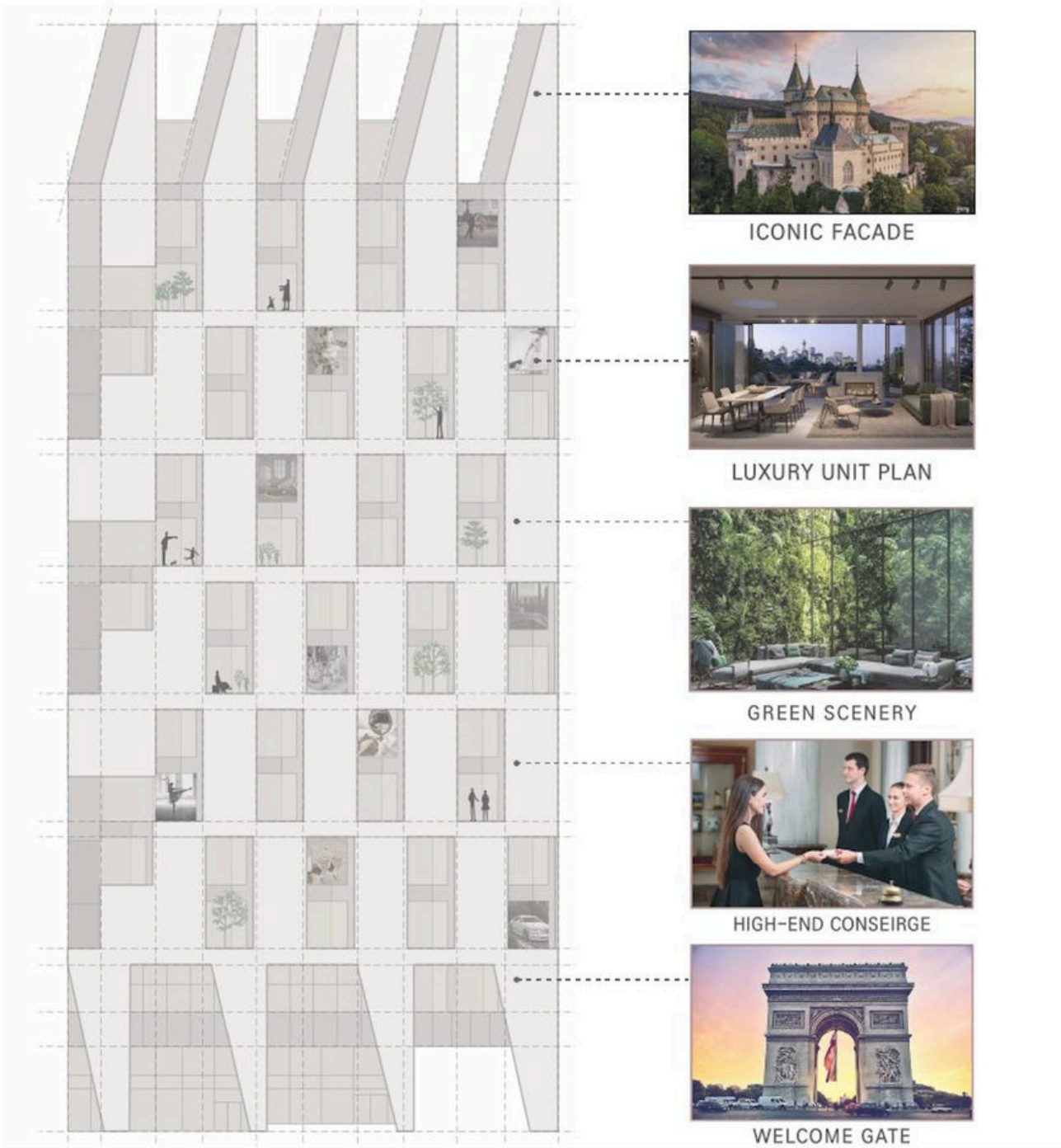

SONO DOSAN proposes a new residential culture in Gangnam for urban residents seeking a more refined way of living. It is designed as a dynamic living landscape where architecture, lifestyle, culture, and art coexist. The project connects the exterior form and interior space through a unified design principle, creating a residence where the outer concept and inner experience naturally communicate. Residential units are reinterpreted as creative living forms, presenting a future-oriented luxury residence.



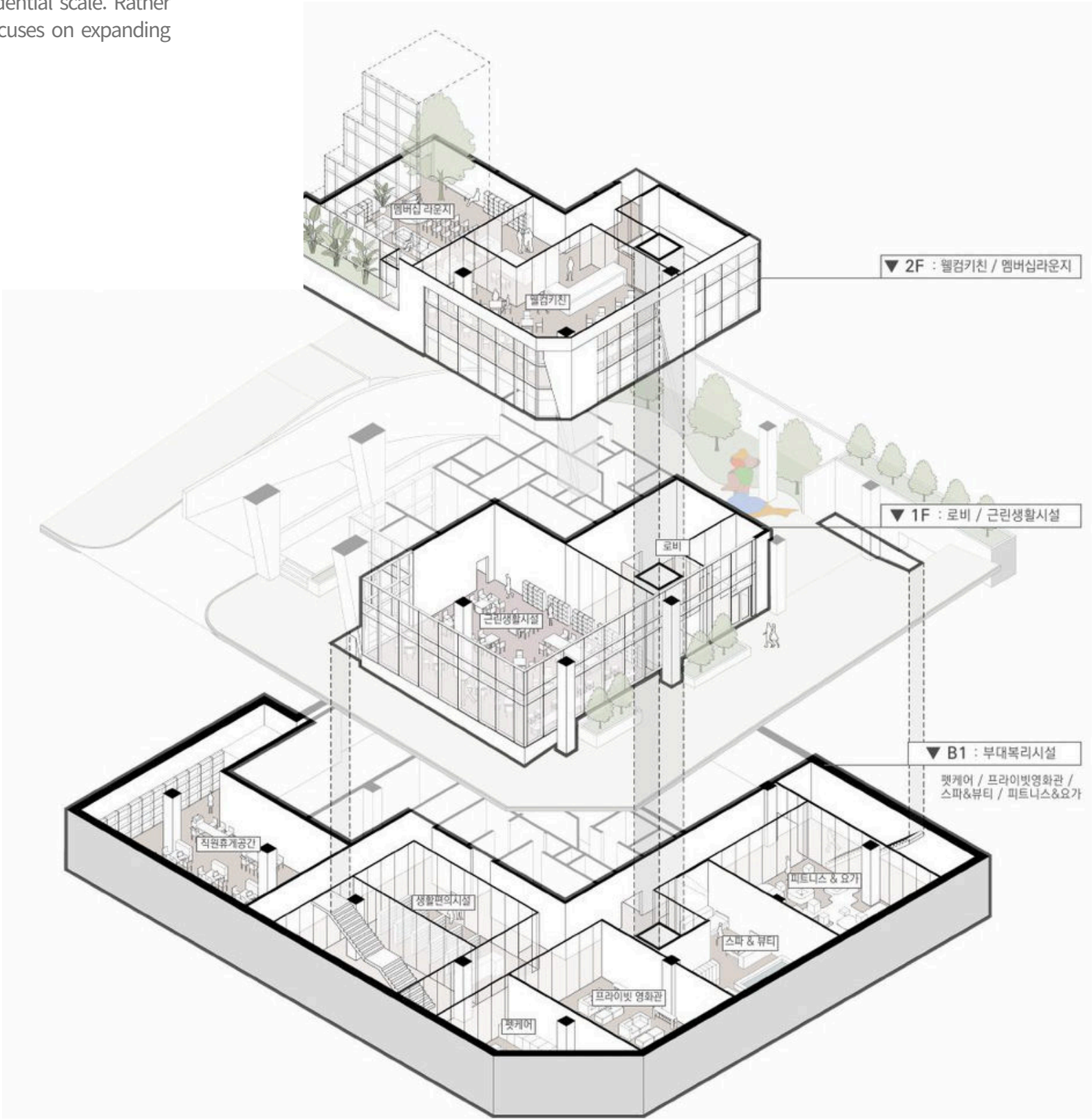
TOTAL CARE CONCIERGE SERVICE

SONO DOSAN proposes a three-dimensional community for residents through distinctive architectural spaces. The shared areas are designed to connect the ground floor, basement, and second floor, overcoming the limits of a typical residential scale. Rather than defining luxury living through hotel-like services, the project focuses on expanding the spaces where residents can live, interact, and feel at home.

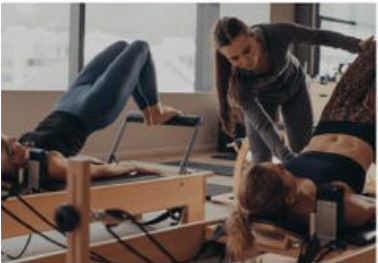

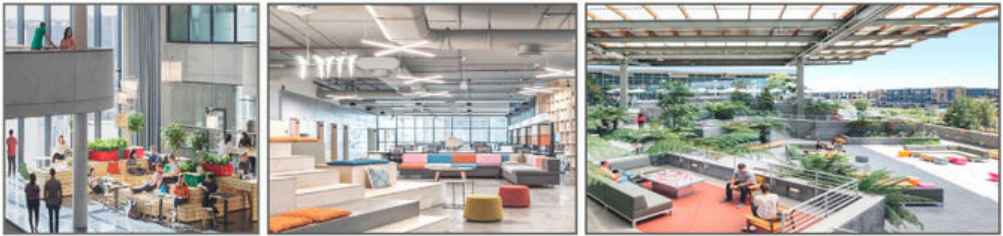
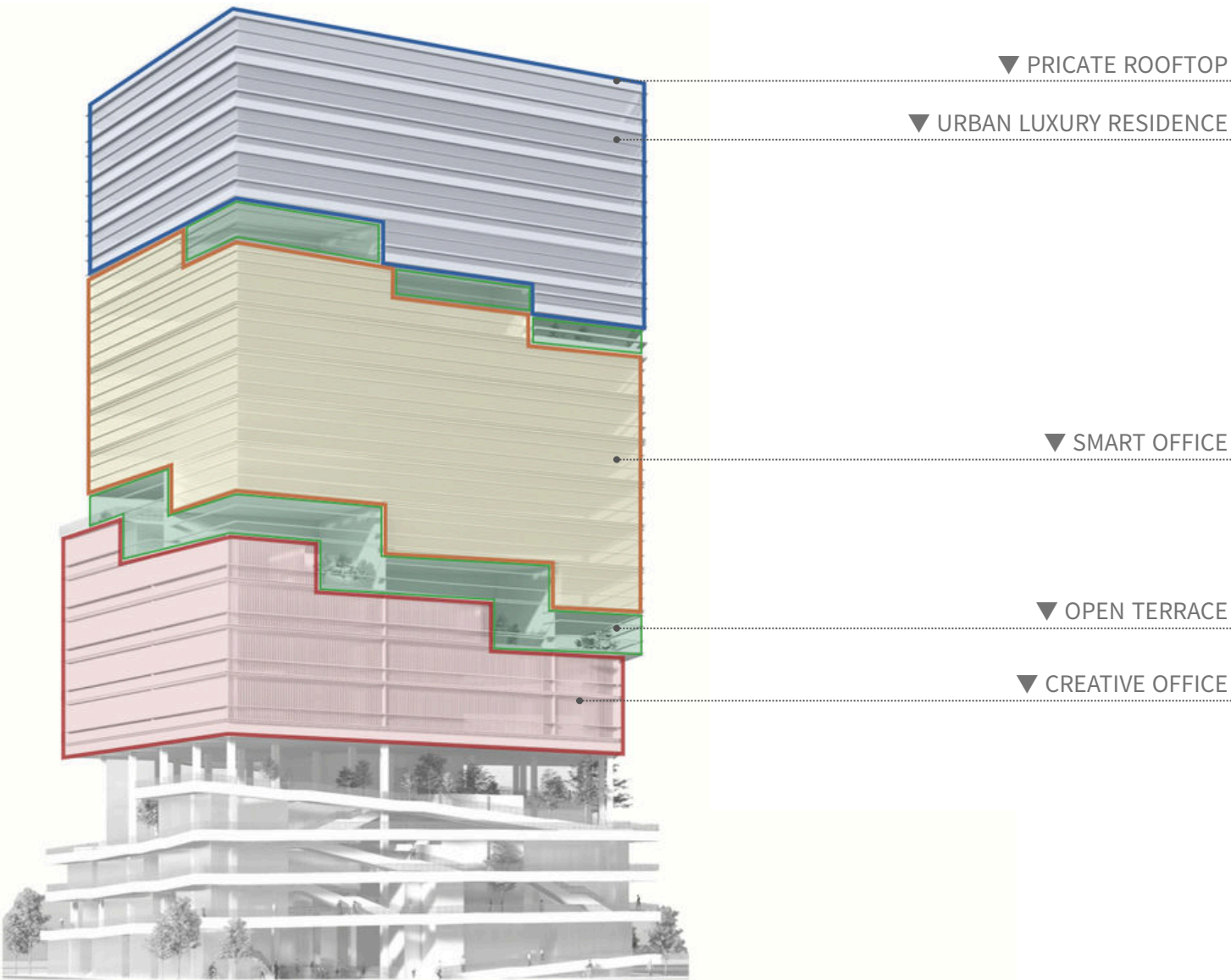
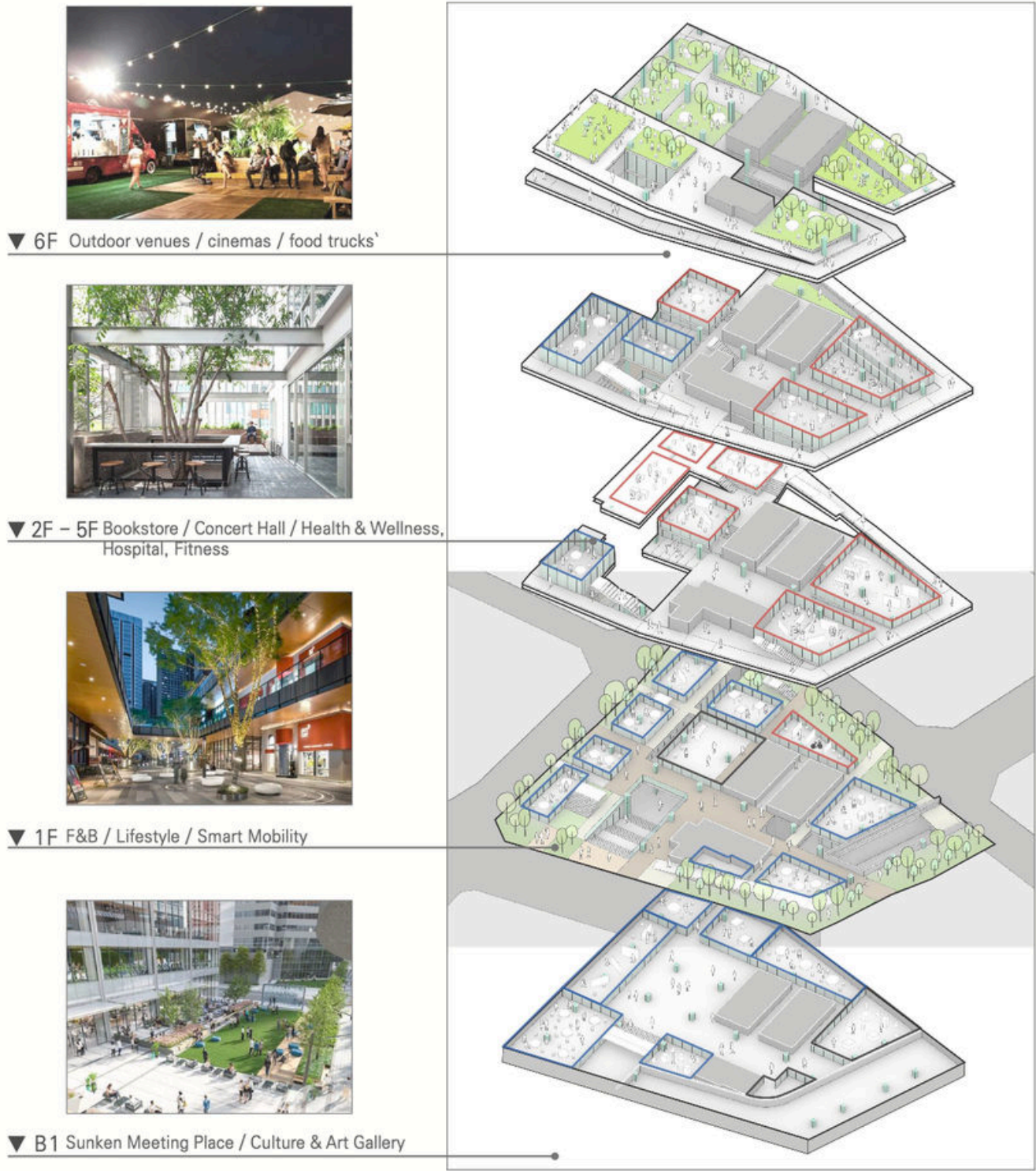


Ramp Up Tower is a cultural complex located in the heart of Seoul. The lower levels include neighborhood facilities and an urban park, surrounded by a continuous ramp. The upper floors consist of workspaces and urban residences. The ramp wraps around the building like an urban promenade, connecting various programs such as restaurants, florists, galleries, book cafés, record shops, and performance venues



Urban Playground & Creative Office

Ramp Up Tower is divided into two main parts: a public urban playground on the lower levels and creative offices on the upper floors. The lower levels respond to the polygonal site and are connected by a continuous ramp, creating a vertical urban park open to Seoul citizens. Through model studies, the design maximizes shared spaces and proposes an urban playground within the city center. The upper floors are planned as compact and flexible offices, with two floors organized as one unit to support openness, connectivity, and creative work.

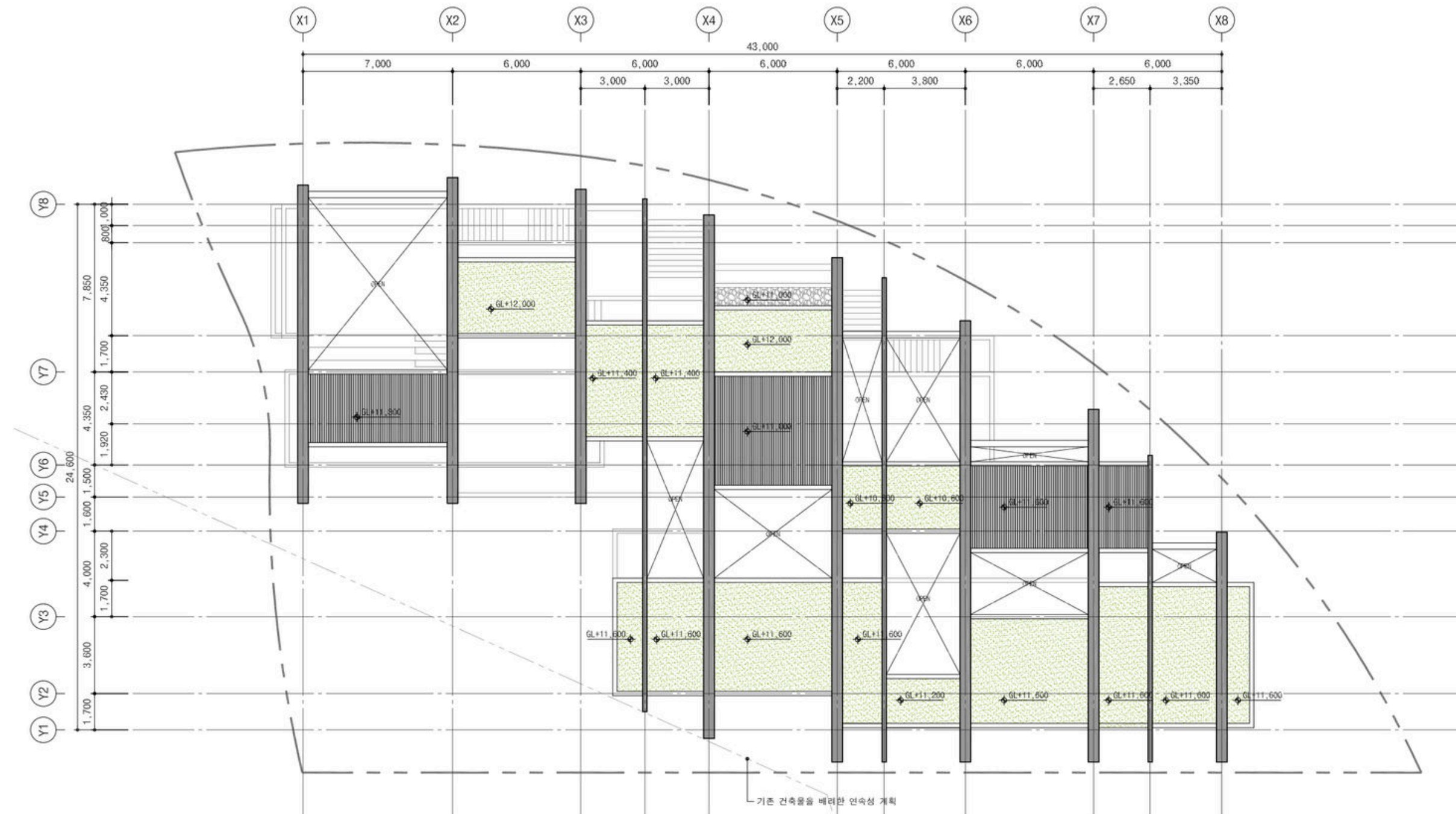

Chronotope Wall is organized around thirteen walls that redefine the relationship between architecture, nature, and program. The three-story building includes galleries, neighborhood facilities, and office spaces, which are organically connected through the walls. Rather than separating each program, the walls allow spaces to penetrate and relate to one another, creating a continuous sequence of gardens, terraces, rooftops, and interior experiences.
